However, Paul Revere is remembered far more for his famous “Midnight Ride” to warn the Colonists of the approaching British attack He was also an express rider and would ride his horse at all hours of the day and night to deliver secret messages Henry Wadsworth Longfellow’s 1860 poetic account embellished the event 85 years later
