H-3109-1 - Leasing Under Special Acts

The Act of May 21, 1930, is the exclusive leasing authority for oil and gas underlying a right-of-way or easement issued pursuant to the general railroad right-of-way statute, the Act of March 3, 1875, and to rights-of-way issued pursuant to the Act of March 3, 1891 (See Champlin Petroleum Co, 68 IBLA 142 (1982)) The Department of the

SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES

Congress passed the General Railroad Right-of-Way Act of 1875 to provide railroad companies "right[s] of way through the public lands of the United States," 43 U S C §934 One such right of way, obtained by a railroad in 1908, crosses land that the United States conveyed to the Brandt family in a 1976 land patent That patent stated

Rights-of-Way Across National Forests

Rights-of-Way Across National Forests The Act of June 4, 1897, does not grant a right of access to owners of land surrounded by national forests, other than actual settlers, and the Secretary of Agriculture has discretionary authority to deny such access unless a right otherwise exists
